Summary Annual Report for California Field Iron Worker Vacation/Personal Time Off (PTO) Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the California Field Iron Worker Vacation/Personal Time Off (PTO) Plan, Employer Identification Number 95-6042867, for the year ended May 31, 2018. The annual report has been filed with the Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The Board of Trustees of California Field Iron Worker Vacation/Personal Time Off (PTO) Plan has committed itself to pay certain vacation benefit claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$2,701,381 as of May 31, 2018, compared to \$2,173,235 as of June 1, 2017. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$528,146. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$77,041,165, including employer contributions of \$76,718,945, earnings from investments of \$225,309, and other income of \$96,911.

Plan expenses were \$76,513,019. These expenses included \$1,272,135 in administrative expenses and \$75,240,884 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.
